Young: 6-8 offspring, up to 3 times per year  
Activity: nocturnal, crepuscular; morning, evening, night, year-round  
Health Risks: tularemia, biting, parasites

Young: 2-6 offspring, up to 2 litters per year  
Activity: nocturnal; active year-round  
Health Risks: fire to your home, biohazard, fleas

Activity: mostly nocturnal, crepuscular  
Health Risks: rabies, distemper, coccidiosis, round worm, tape worm, fleas, lice, ticks

Habitat: suburban, city, parks, fields, woods  
Food: omnivore; pets, small mammals, reptiles, amphibians, birds, eggs, insects, fruit

Activity: nocturnal, crepuscular, diurnal  
Health Risks: rabies, distemper, coccidiosis, round worm, tape worm, fleas, lice, ticks

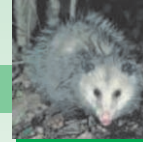
## GEESE

Health Risks: slip and fall from droppings

Young: 2-13 offspring, once per year  
Activity: nocturnal; morning, evening, night  
Health Risks: tapeworm, roundworm, fleas, lice, ticks
