

CHIPMUNK



Life Expectancy: 2-4 years
 Habitat: human dwellings, stone walls, rock piles
 Food: omnivore; seeds, fruit, nuts, insects, flowers, frogs, baby birds and eggs, small snakes
 Breeding: Mar-Apr
 Young: 1-7 offspring, 1-2 times per year, May-June
 Activity: diurnal; peak activity morning and evening
 Health Risks: fire, flies, ticks
Solution: Berg's Nuisance Animal Control!

MOLE (eastern or star-nosed)



Life Expectancy: 1-2 years
 Habitat: lawns, gardens, wet lands, ponds, streams
 Food: insectivore, carnivore, herbivore; earthworms, grubs, insects, roots, slugs
 Breeding: Feb-May
 Young: 2-7 offspring, once per year
 Activity: diurnal, nocturnal; active year-round
 Health Risks: fleas, lice, ticks, trip and fall
Solution: Berg's Nuisance Animal Control!

PIGEONS



Life Expectancy: 4-22 years
 Habitat: homes, businesses, barnyards, bridges, parks
 Food: seeds, grain
 Breeding: Spring-Fall
 Young: 1-2 offspring, up to 4 times per year
 Activity: day
 Health Risks: encephalitis, histoplasmosis, cryptococcosis, toxoplasmosis, pseudo-tuberculosis
Solution: Berg's Nuisance Animal Control!

GROUND HOG



Life Expectancy: 2-4 years
 Habitat: around houses, buildings, fields, woodlands
 Food: herbivore; green vegetation, leaf buds, grasses
 Breeding: Mar-Apr
 Young: 3-7 offspring, once per year
 Activity: diurnal; most active morning and evening
 Health Risks: rabies, scabies, ticks, fleas, lice
Solution: Berg's Nuisance Animal Control!

BEAVER



Life Expectancy: 10-15 years
 Habitat: rivers, streams, ditches, lakes, ponds
 Food: herbivore, bark of trees, aquatic plants, green leaves
 Breeding: Jan-Mar
 Young: 1-8 offspring, once per year
 Activity: nocturnal, crepuscular; morning, evening, night, year-round
 Health Risks: giardia, tularemia, blastomakosis
Solution: Berg's Nuisance Animal Control!

BAT



Life Expectancy: 10-20 years
 Habitat: forests, suburban areas, houses, attics, walls
 Food: insectivore; insects, midges, mosquitoes
 Breeding: August – September
 Young: 1 offspring, once per year May - July
 Activity: nocturnal; active only on warm dry nights
 Health Risks: rabies, histoplasmosis
Solution: Berg's Nuisance Animal Control!

SQUIRREL (fox, gray, red)



Life Expectancy: 2-5 years
 Habitat: woodlands, suburban yards, houses, attics
 Food: omnivore; seeds, nuts, fruit, corn, baby birds or eggs
 Breeding: Jan-Feb
 Young: 2-6 offspring, sometimes twice per year
 Activity: diurnal; active year-round, throughout day
 Health Risks: fire, biohazard, tapeworm, roundworm
Solution: Berg's Nuisance Animal Control!

MICE



Life Expectancy: 1-2 years
 Habitat: houses, buildings, yards, fields, woodlands
 Food: herbivore, insectivore, omnivore; seeds, fruit, nuts, insects, baby birds
 Breeding: Mar-Oct
 Young: 2-15 offspring, up to 4 times per year
 Activity: mostly nocturnal
 Health Risks: salmonellosis, rickettsia pox, hantavirus, tapeworm, infectious jaundice, and tularemia
Solution: Berg's Nuisance Animal Control!

DEER



Life Expectancy: 5-10 years
 Habitat: all habitats, yards, parks, golf courses
 Food: herbivore; grass, flowers, bushes, trees, acorns, seeds
 Breeding: Oct-Nov
 Young: 1-2 offspring, once per year, May-June
 Activity: nocturnal, crepuscular; mornings, evening, night
 Health Risks: ticks, tuberculosis, car accidents
Solution: Berg's Nuisance Animal Control!

RAT



Life Expectancy: 2-4 years
 Habitat: associated with people, city, houses, dumps, farms
 Food: omnivore; seeds, nuts, insects, small mammals, birds, bird eggs
 Breeding: year round
 Young: 2-9 offspring, up to 10 times per year
 Activity: nocturnal; active year-round
 Health Risks: salmonellosis, rickettsia pox, hantavirus, tapeworm, infectious jaundice, and tularemia

 Habitat: woodlands, river bottoms, urban areas, under houses
 Food: omnivore; insects, small mammals, earthworms, bird eggs, amphibians, reptiles, fruit, nuts
 Breeding: Feb.-Apr
 Young: 4-7 offspring, once per year, musky odor 8-10 days
 Activity: mostly nocturnal
 Health Risks: rabies, distemper, scabies, flies, ticks

RACCOON

Life Expectancy: 6-10 years
 Habitat: wetlands to woodlands, houses, attics, chimneys
 Food: omnivore; crayfish, fish, small mammals, fruit, nuts, bird seed, bird eggs, amphibians, reptiles
 Breeding: Feb-June
 Young: 3-6 offspring, once per year
 Activity: nocturnal; active year-round
 Health Risks: raccoon roundworm, rabies, tapeworm, distemper, tuberculosis, fleas, ticks
